



## POST FIH CONGRESS REPORT

### Elections Oversight Panel

**DATE : 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022**

At the Congress, which was held virtually (online), the elections were as follows:

For FIH Presidency, there were 2 candidates for 1 position. Marc Coudron and Tayyab Ikram. Tayyab Ikram obtained the largest number of votes and the absolute majority required by the rules and was therefore elected.

There were 3 candidates for the position of female member of Executive Board. Maureen Craig – Rousseau and Elizabeth Safoa King obtained the most votes and an absolute majority required by the rules and were each declared elected.

For the male candidates for Executive Board who were 6, the successful candidates were Anzai Hiroya, Piotr Wilkonski and Deon Morgan who each obtained the necessary absolute majority.

At the congress, an Independent Notary, Mr. Luis Hyde-Vaamonde from the UK firm of Cheeswrights Scrivener Notaries LLP was sitting in Lumi's offices next to the voting machine with the responsibility for chairing the elections procedure under powers delegated by the Elections Oversight Panel.
