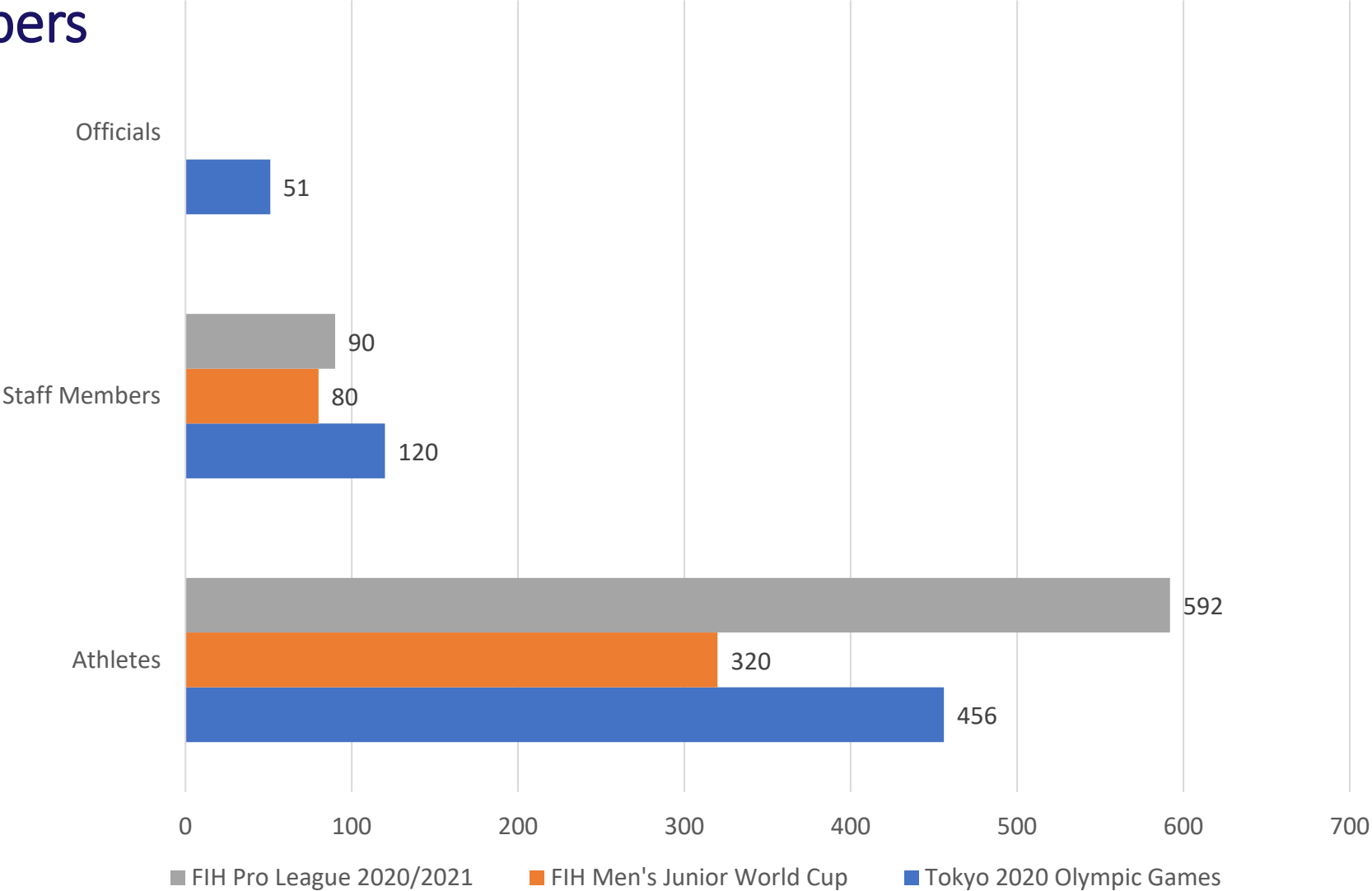
Summary of Activities

The FIH Anti-Doping Education plan for 2021 included a blend of face to face and remote online learning activities.

Unfortunately, due to the pandemic scenario that prevented our staff from attending our events, we were unable to implement any face-to-face training and therefore, the International Hockey Federation (FIH) focused on online education tools and used the Adel Platform as the main tool to keep education athletes, staff members and officials.

As a result of these initiatives, around 1000 athletes (a few that played the Olympics also played FIH Pro league), 200 staff members (coaches, physical trainers, doctors, physios and Team managers) and 51 technical officials were able to complete educational modules which contributed to have clean Events organized by FIH in 2021.
