## Qualification pathway - Olympic Games Paris 2024

### Men's and women's competitions

Number of quota places per gender	Qualification events
<b>1 team</b>	<p><b>Host country</b> The host country of the Olympic Games shall be allocated one quota place.</p>
<b>5 teams</b>	<p><b>Continental Qualifications</b> The winner of each of the five (5) continental championships, of the below competitions will earn one (1) quota place for their NOC:</p> <p>African Hockey Road to Paris 2023 Pan American Games 2023 Asian Games 2022 EuroHockey Championship 2023 Oceania Cup 2023</p> <p>Should the host country, also win the EuroHockey Championship 2023, the second placed nation does not subsequently qualify and the quota place will be allocated to the Olympic Qualification Tournaments below.</p>
<b>6 teams</b>	<p><b>FIH Olympic Qualification Tournaments</b> There will be 2 (two) FIH Olympic Qualification Tournaments, consisting of eight (8) teams each (16 teams in total), held in the period from 13-21 January 2024. The tournament format will be the same as that used in the FIH Nations Cup, with two (2) pools of four (4), then semi-finals and a final. The top three (3) teams in each of these tournaments will earn one (1) quota place for their NOC.</p> <p>If the host country, is the highest placed in the EuroHockey Championships, then a 7th quota place will be available in the Olympic Qualification Tournaments. This will be offered to the highest ranked of the two (2) teams who finish 4th in the Olympic Qualification Tournaments, at midnight on the final day of the second tournament to finish.</p> <p>The teams invited to participate in these tournaments will be based on continental quotas, determined by the number of nations from each continent who are World Ranked in the top 22 Olympic eligible nations on 31 January 2023.</p>



*Note: as Great Britain take part in the Olympics, only 1 British nation, England, will be considered as part of the quotas. Scotland and Wales will not, and therefore if either are also ranked in the top 22 of the World Rankings, then the nations ranked down to 23 or 24 will be used to calculate the quotas.*

From these 22 quotas, the continents of the six (6) nations already qualified will be removed, leaving 16 continental quotas. These 16 continental quotas would be filled by the highest finishing nations in each continental championship who have not already qualified for Paris 2024.

Should any nation not accept their invitation to participate in the qualifying tournament, the next reserve nation will be invited. The reserve nations are determined using the same continental quota system as above, and not by replacing a nation with the next nation in that particular continent. Therefore, the nation from the continent with an eligible team ranked 23rd in the FIH World Rankings on January 31, 2023, will be the first reserve.

The continental quotas, including reserves, will be published on February 1st, 2023. The snake system will be used to allocate the 16 nations into the two Olympic Qualification Tournaments, as shown below.

Snake system

Ranking order of 16 teams in Olympic Qualification Tournaments

Tournament A	1, 4, 5, 8, 9, 12, 13, 16
Tournament B	2, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14, 15

*Note: If the 2 hosts are allocated by the snake system to participate in the same tournament, then the lower ranked host will be swapped into the other tournament with the equivalent ranked team allocated to the other tournament.*

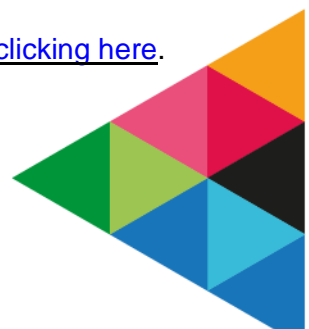
