Athlete Eligibility

Age

To be eligible to participate in the FIH World Hockey5s Youth Event, athletes must have been born between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2011.

Qualification Pathway

The 12-team tournament for both men and women shall consist of two (2) national teams from each Continental Championship Qualifier, the host and an additional team from the Continent of the winner of the last Youth Olympic Games, Buenos Aires 2018.

Each continent will organise one Continental Hockey5s Qualification Tournaments:

- Africa will organise a Hockey5s tournament (men and women: dates and venue to be confirmed)
- Asia will organise a Hockey5s tournament (men and women: dates and venue to be confirmed)
- Europe already organized a Hockey5s tournament (men and women: 3 - 6 July 2024, Zagreb, Croatia)
- Oceania will organise a Hockey5s tournament (men and women: dates and venue to be confirmed)
- Pan America will organise a Hockey5s tournament (men and women: dates and venue to be confirmed)

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country will automatically qualify one (1) men's and one (1) women's team to the Event.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Any unused Host Country Places will be reallocated to the next best-ranked Team of the respective gender, not yet qualified under D.1, from the African Hockey5s qualifying tournament.

If the quota place is still available, the quota place will be reallocated using the same principles established under section D.2 of Reallocation of Unused Quota Place.

Confirmation process for quota places

CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

FIH shall confirm the qualification place(s) immediately following each qualifying event. National Associations will then have to confirm in writing to the FIH confirming their participation by 1st June 2026

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES

D.1

Any unused quota places through D.1, in both genders, will be reallocated to the next best-ranked team in the Continental Hockey5s Qualification Tournament of the team that rejected the invitation.

D.2.

Any unused quota places through D.2, in both genders, will be reallocated to the Continent of next best-ranked team in the last Youth Olympic Games, Buenos Aires 2018, not yet qualified under D.1 or under the host country quota, following the order of priority below:
