REPORT DECISION DISCIPLINARY HEARING REGARDING: Adam KAPASI, PLAYER #20 OF CANADA

Charge: Breach of Code of Conduct

2.2 h. Abuse of hockey equipment or clothing, venue equipment or fixtures and fittings. Note: This includes any action(s) outside the course of normal hockey actions, such as hitting or kicking the goal posts and any action(s) which intentionally or negligently results in damage to the team benches, advertising boards, dressing room doors, mirrors, windows and other fixtures and fittings.

The disciplinary history of the team member: Not available

The attitude of the team member at the hearing: Adam KAPASI was very apologetic for his actions and understands the consequences. He stated that he lost his composure due to the match results and understands that these actions are unacceptable and should not occur. Adam additionally presented a written statement apologizing for his actions and will reinforce the importance of sportmanship and discipline moving forward. Furthermore, the Assistant Coach Reginald PEREIRA agrees that the actions of Adam are not acceptable and the team staff have met with with Adam to take steps for counseling and education. A written statement from Head Coach John DeSouza on behalf of the CAN coaching staff was presented with their deepest apologies and the team's efforts to empahize upholding the Tournament Regulations and Code of Conduct moving forward.

Any penalty already incurred: none

Decision - Breach of Code of Conduct
