- Nottingham, England – O35M and O40M, O35W and O40W
- Cape Town, South Africa, O45M – O55M & O45W – O65W
- Tokyo, Japan, O60M – O80M

## Results

- Nottingham – 25 mens and 25 womens teams participated
- Cape Town – 42 mens teams and 42 womens teams entered
- Tokyo – 27 teams entered
