FIH Hockey World Cup 2026 – Early Bird Pass Prize Draw

Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter

The promoter is the International Hockey Federation (FIH), Rue du Valentin 61, 1004 Lausanne, Switzerland.

2. Eligible Purchase Period

The prize draw applies to all Early Bird Passes purchased up to and including 28 June 2026 at 23:59 CEST. This includes Early Bird Passes purchased before the prize draw was officially announced, provided they were purchased during the Early Bird Pass sales period. Any Early Bird Passes purchased after this deadline will not be eligible for the draw.

3. Eligibility

- The draw is open to individuals aged 18 years or older at the time of purchase, worldwide.
- Employees of the FIH, its member associations, tournament organizing committees, or anyone professionally connected to the campaign are excluded from winning.
- Entry is subject to local laws. Void where prohibited by law.

4. How to Enter

- Entry is automatic. Anyone who has successfully purchased or purchases an Early Bird Pass for the FIH Hockey World Cup 2026 by 28 June 2026 at 23:59 CEST will receive one (1) entry into the prize draw per pass purchased.
- No alternative method of entry is required.

5. The Prizes and Limitations

There are two (2) separate prizes available to be won:

- Prize A: Two (2) general admission tickets to the FIH Hockey Women's World Cup Final.
- Prize B: Two (2) general admission tickets to the FIH Hockey Men's World Cup Final.
- Note: The prize includes tickets only. Travel, flights, accommodation, visas, meals, and any other personal expenses are the sole responsibility of the winners. Tickets are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
- Obtaining necessary travel visas or entry requirements to Belgium/the Netherlands is the sole responsibility of the winner. FIH will not provide fast-track documentation.

6. Winner Selection and Notification

- Two (2) unique winners will be selected at random from all eligible entries using a computer-generated random draw.
- The draw will take place within seven (7) days of the campaign closing date, by 5 July 2026.
- Winners will be contacted directly via the email address used to purchase their Early Bird Pass.
- If a winner does not respond within fourteen (14) days of notification, the FIH reserves the right to forfeit the prize and select a runner-up.

Personal data collected during ticket purchase will be processed in accordance with the FIH Privacy Policy and will be used strictly for the administration of this draw and ticket fulfillment.
